 - Collaboration with Mass Speaks Coalition on policy advocacy work

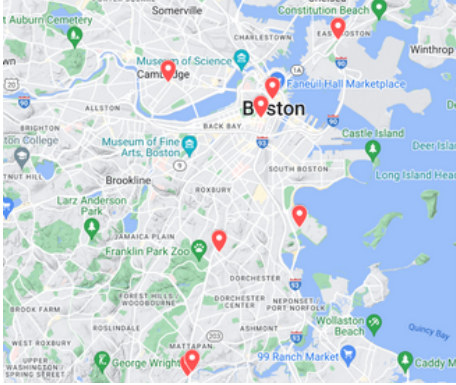
Recent Advances
